- 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
- 10 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 24, Chapter 413, O.S.L.
- 11 2003 (68 O.S. Supp. 2004, Section 1354.31), is amended to read as
- 12 follows:
- 13 Section 1354.31 A. If the Oklahoma Tax Commission enters into
- 14 the Streamlined Sales and Use Tax Agreement under Section 1354.18 of
- 15 Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes this title, the Tax Commission is
- 16 authorized to provide a monetary allowance from the taxes collected
- 17 to each of the following:
- 18 1. A certified service provider, in accordance with the
- 19 agreement and under the terms of the contract signed with the
- 20 provider;
- 21 2. Any vendor registered under the agreement that selects a
- 22 certified automated system to perform part of its sales or use tax
- 23 functions; and

- 1 3. Any vendor registered under the agreement that uses a
- 2 proprietary system to calculate taxes due and has entered into a
- 3 performance agreement with states that are members to the
- 4 Streamlined Sales and Use Tax Agreement.
- 5 B. The monetary allowance provided for in paragraph 2 or 3 of
- 6 subsection A of this section shall be given to the vendor for the
- 7 period established by, and at the rate set in, the Streamlined Sales
- 8 and Use Tax Agreement entered into under Section 1354.18 of Title 68
- 9 of the Oklahoma Statutes this title if the Tax Commission determines
- 10 that such terms are reasonable and provide adequate incentive for
- 11 such vendors.
- 12 C. The monetary allowance provided for in this section shall be
- 13 in lieu of the deduction provided for in Section 1367.1 of this
- 14 title.
- 15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.
