14	WHEREAS, the Board on Judicial Compensation convening on
15	September 20, 2011, in accordance with the provisions of Section 3.3
16	of Title 20 of the Oklahoma Statutes issued a final report
17	increasing judicial salaries; and
18	WHEREAS, salary increases were approved for the Chief Justice of
19	the Supreme Court, Associate Justices of the Supreme Court, the
20	Presiding Judge of the Court of Criminal Appeals, Judges of the
21	Court of Criminal Appeals, the Presiding Judge of the Court of Civil
22	Appeals, Judges of the Court of Civil Appeals, District Court
23	Judges, Associate District Court Judges, and Special Judges; and

1 WHEREAS, the Final Report of the Board stated that the salaries 2 increases were "a six percent (6%) cost of living increase due to 3 inflation from July 1, 2008, to date"; and WHEREAS, the Legislature, as the branch of state government 4 5 designated to enact a budget and appropriate funds for the operation of state government, must ensure that all expenditures of state 6 funds are made in a manner that is fiscally prudent; and 7 WHEREAS, the action of the Board does not reflect the will of 9 the Legislature. 10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 11 AND THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 53RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE: 12 SECTION 1. Pursuant to the authority of the Legislature, as 13 provided in Section 3.2 of Title 20 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Final Report of the Board on Judicial Compensation, issued on 14 15 September 20, 2011, establishing a six-percent cost-of-living pay increase for judges is hereby disapproved. 16 SECTION 2.
