17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:							
18	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 29 O.S. 2011, Section 7-205, as							
19	amended by Section 2, Chapter 286, O.S.L. 2013 (29 O.S. Supp. 2015,							
20	Section 7-205), is amended to read as follows:							
21	Section 7-205. A. Excluding furbearers and coyotes, no person							
22	may capture, kill, mutilate or destroy any wildlife protected by law							
23	and remove the head, claws, teeth, hide, antlers, horns or any or							
24	all of such parts from the body with the intent to abandon the body

B. Excluding furbearers and coyotes, no person may capture or
mutilate any living wildlife protected by law by removing the claws,
teeth, hide, antlers, horns or any or all of such parts from the
body.

7 C. No person may kill any wildlife protected by law and abandon 8 the body without disposing of the body in the most appropriate 9 manner.

D. Any person convicted of violating the provisions of this section shall be punished by a fine of not less than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) nor more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than one (1) year, or by both fine and imprisonment.

E. D. Any hunting or fishing license issued to a any person by 15 the Department of Wildlife Conservation shall be automatically 16 revoked upon conviction of the that person of for violating the 17 provisions any provision of this section. The revocation shall be 18 for a period set by the court of not less than one (1) year nor more 19 than ten (10) years. If the court does not set a period, the 20 revocation shall be for one (1) year from the date of the 21 conviction. During this period of the revocation period, the 22 Department shall not issue the person a hunting or fishing license. 23 If the court does not set a revocation period, the Department shall 24

1	not issue that person a license within one (1) year of the

3	a license or permit revoked pursuant to this section shall surrender							
4	the revoked license or permit to the court. The court shall send

11	ducks, gallinules, geese, grouse, partridge, pheasant, quail,							
12	prairie chickens, rails, snipes, swans, wild turkey and woodcock;							
13	2. "Game mammal" means deer, elk, bear, bighorn sheep,							
14	antelope, cottontail rabbit, swamp rabbit, and squirrel;							
15	3. "Game fish" means largemouth bass, smallmouth bass, white							
16	bass, spotted bass, black crappie, white crappie, northern pike,							
17	trout, sauger, saugeye, striped bass, hybrid striped bass, walleye,							
18	paddlefish, blue catfish, flathead catfish and channel catfish; and							
19	4. "Edible meat" shall mean:							
20	a. for game birds, the breast meat,							
21	b. for game mammals, the four quarters and loins or							
22	backstrap, and							
23	c. for game fish, the two fillets.
