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- 3. "Retrieval" means ovulation induction and procedure to obtain the eggs or sperm. It does not include subsequent storage, disposition, fertilization, or subsequent transplantation.
- B. Any health benefit plan including the State and Education Employees Group Health Insurance Plan, that is offered, issued, or renewed in this state on or after the effective date of this act shall provide coverage for retrieval of eggs or sperm in a covered person who will receive a medically necessary treatment including surgery, chemotherapy, and radiation, that has been medically determined to cause iatrogenic infertility.
- C. The coverage provided by this section shall be subject to the same annual deductibles, copayments, or coinsurance limits as established for all covered benefits under the health benefit plan.

  SECTION 2. This act shall become effective January 1, 2023.

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
