18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 481, as
20 amended by Section 1, Chapter 349, O.S.L. 2013 (59 O.S. Supp. 2018,
21 Section 481), is amended to read as follows:

22 Section 481. A State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision
23 hereinafter referred to as the "Board", is hereby re-created, to
24 continue until July 1, ~~2019~~ 2024, in accordance with the provisions

1 of the Oklahoma Sunset Law. The Board shall be composed of seven
2 (7) allopathic physicians licensed to practice medicine in this
3 state and represent the public and ~~two (2)~~ four (4) lay members.
4 The physician members of the Board shall be graduates of legally
5 chartered medical schools recognized by the Oklahoma State Regents
6 for Higher Education or the Liaison Council on Medical Education.
7 The physician members shall have actively practiced as licensed
8 physicians continuously in this state for the three (3) years
9 immediately preceding their appointment to the Board. All members
10 of the Board shall be residents of this state and shall be appointed
11 by the Governor as provided for in Section 482 of this title. All
12 present members of the Board shall continue to serve for the
13 remainder of their current terms."
