entire bill and insert

2018, Section 2-125), which relates to the deposit  
18 and expenditure of funds; allowing county sheriffs to  
collect certain fees; directing where collected fees  
19 shall be deposited; specifying use of received fees;  
and providing an effective date.

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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 2-125, as  
23 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 265, O.S.L. 2017 (47 O.S. Supp.  
24 2018, Section 2-125), is amended to read as follows:

1       Section 2-125. The Commissioner of Public Safety shall assess  
2 and collect costs and fees from subscribers to the Oklahoma Law  
3 Enforcement Telecommunication System (OLETS), to be deposited in the  
4 State Treasury to the credit of the Department of Public Safety  
5 Restricted Revolving Fund. Such costs and fees expended from the  
6 fund shall be for personnel, recurring user fees, necessary hardware  
7 and accessories, installation of equipment, maintenance and  
8 operational expenses for ~~the Oklahoma Law Enforcement~~  
9 ~~Telecommunication System~~ OLETS. If a county sheriff offers hosting  
10 services of end users that allows for a connection to OLETS, the  
11 sheriff may assess and collect fees for the itemized actual costs of  
12 providing personnel, reoccurring user fees, necessary hardware and  
13 accessories, installation of equipment, maintenance, training and  
14 operational expenses for the utilization of the hosting data system  
15 and shall provide the terms and itemized costs in an inter-local  
16 agreement between both parties. The agreement shall be filed with  
17 the office of the county clerk and in the offices of each  
18 governmental entity involved. Fees generated through this section  
19 shall be deposited in the Sheriff's Service Fee Account for the sole  
20 use of the purposes outlined in this section.

21       SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019."

16 SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 2-125, as  
17 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 265, O.S.L. 2017 (47 O.S. Supp.  
18 2018, Section 2-125), is amended to read as follows:

19 Section 2-125. The Commissioner of Public Safety shall assess  
20 and collect costs and fees from subscribers to the Oklahoma Law  
21 Enforcement Telecommunication System, to be deposited in the State  
22 Treasury to the credit of the Department of Public Safety Restricted  
23 Revolving Fund. Such costs and fees expended from the fund shall be  
24 for personnel, recurring user fees, necessary hardware and  
accessories, installation of equipment, maintenance and operational

1 expenses for the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Telecommunication System.  
2 If a county sheriff offers hosting services, the sheriff may assess  
3 and collect costs and fees from any such agency to be deposited in  
4 the Sheriff's Service Fee Account. Such costs and fees expended  
5 from the account shall be for personnel, recurring user fees,  
6 necessary hardware and accessories, installation of equipment,  
7 maintenance and operational expenses for the hosting system.

8 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
