8 An Act relating to drug testing; creating the
9 Oklahoma Drug Testing Reform Act; providing for
10 standards for certain entities; requiring usage of
11 best practices and guidelines; providing for certain
12 training qualifications; providing for codification;
13 and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 566 of Title 40, unless there is
17 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma
19 Drug Testing Reform Act".

20 B. The Oklahoma Drug Testing Reform Act provides the standards
21 for drug and alcohol testing required or requested by employers and
22 for federal, state, county and municipal service providers,
23 including probation and parole service providers, private probation
24 persons, the Department of Corrections, any state-authorized court
and community-based treatment programs.

1 C. The entities referenced in subsection B of this section
2 shall be excluded from any additional mandates and shall follow the
3 best practices and guidelines outlined in 49 CFR Part 40. All drug
4 testing shall be conducted by personnel meeting the training
5 qualifications found in 49 CFR Part 40.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
