PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending
21 O.S. 2011, Sections 650.4 and 650.5, which relate
to penalties for assault and battery and aggravated
assault and battery upon emergency medical care
providers; expanding scope of unlawful acts to
include all medical care providers; modifying
definition to include certain medical care providers;
modifying penalties; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 650.4, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 650.4 A. Every person who, without justifiable or
excusable cause and with intent to do bodily harm, commits any
assault, battery or assault and battery upon the person of ~~an~~
~~emergency~~ a medical care provider who is performing medical care
duties, upon conviction, is guilty of a felony punishable by
imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for a
term not exceeding ~~two (2) years~~ one (1) year, or by a fine not

1 exceeding One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by both such fine and
2 imprisonment.

3 B. As used in this section, "~~emergency~~ medical care provider"
4 means doctors, residents, interns, nurses, nurses' aides, ambulance
5 attendants and operators, paramedics, emergency medical technicians,
6 laboratory technicians, radiologic technologists and members of a
7 hospital security force.

8 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 650.5, is
9 amended to read as follows:

10 Section 650.5. Every person who, without justifiable or
11 excusable cause and with intent to do bodily harm, commits any
12 aggravated assault and battery or any assault with a firearm or
13 other deadly weapon upon the person of ~~an emergency medical~~
14 ~~technician or other emergency~~ a medical care provider, as defined in
15 Section 650.4 of this title, upon conviction, is guilty of a felony
16 punishable by imprisonment in ~~a state correctional institution~~ the
17 custody of the Department of Corrections for a term not ~~more than~~
18 exceeding five (5) years, or by imprisonment in a county jail for a
19 term not exceeding one (1) year, or by a fine not to exceed One
20 Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.

21 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
