- B. As used in this section, "emergency medical care provider" means doctors, residents, interns, nurses, nurses' aides, ambulance attendants and operators, paramedics, emergency medical technicians, laboratory technicians, radiologic technologists and members of a hospital security force.
- SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 650.5, is amended to read as follows:

excusable cause and with intent to do bodily harm, commits any aggravated assault and battery or any assault with a firearm or other deadly weapon upon the person of an emergency medical technician or other emergency a medical care provider, as defined in Section 650.4 of this title, upon conviction, is guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment in a state correctional institution the custody of the Department of Corrections for a term not more than exceeding five (5) years, or by imprisonment in a county jail for a term not exceeding one (1) year, or by a fine not to exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.
