PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to transportation; designating the Deputy Sheriff Michael Dee Pace Memorial Bridge; designating the Landon L. Endres Memorial Interchange; designating the Paul Henry Carr Memorial Bridge; designating the Trooper Leon H. Brown Memorial Highway; designating the 1LT Damon Leehan Memorial Bridge; designating the Deputy Sean Cookson Memorial Highway; designating the Senator E. Melvin Porter Memorial Bridge; designating the Deputy Sheriff Clifford Phillip Payne Memorial Highway; amending Section 3, Chapter 307, O.S.L. 2018 (69 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 1698.271), which relates to the SSG Christopher Michael Hake Memorial Bridge; modifying name and location of markers; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.287 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The bridge over Choctaw Road on U.S. Highway 69 in Bryan County shall be designated as the "Deputy Sheriff Michael Dee Pace Memorial

1 Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
2 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

3 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.288 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The interchange of Interstate 40 and Cimarron Road in Canadian
7 County shall be designated as the "Landon L. Endres Memorial
8 Interchange". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
9 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

10 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.289 of Title 69, unless
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 The bridge over U.S. Highway 266 on U.S. Highway 69 within the
14 municipal limits of Checotah shall be designated as the "Paul Henry
15 Carr Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
16 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
17 highway.

18 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.290 of Title 69, unless
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 The section of U.S. Highway 77 beginning at the south edge of
22 the municipal limits of Marietta extending southwesterly to the
23 northern municipal limits of Thackerville in Love County shall be
24 designated as the "Trooper Leon H. Brown Memorial Highway". The

1 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
2 bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

3 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.291 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The bridge over Interstate 35 on 4th Street within the municipal
7 limits of Moore shall be designated as the "1LT Damon Leehan
8 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
9 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
10 highway.

11 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.292 of Title 69, unless
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 The portion of State Highway 82 beginning at the junction of
15 State Highway 82 and West Gideon Road in Cherokee County extending
16 southeast to the junction of State Highway 82 and North Elm Grove
17 Road in Cherokee County shall be designated as the "Deputy Sean
18 Cookson Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
19 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
20 the highway.

21 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.293 of Title 69, unless
23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 The bridge over Martin Luther King Avenue on Interstate 44
2 within the municipal limits of Oklahoma City shall be designated as
3 the "Senator E. Melvin Porter Memorial Bridge". The Department of
4 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
5 name to be placed on the highway.

6 SECTION 8. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
7 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.294 of Title 69, unless
8 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

9 The section of State Highway 54 beginning at the Custer County -
10 Washita County line extending southerly to the intersection with
11 State Highway 54B in Washita County shall be designated as the
12 "Deputy Sheriff Clifford Phillip Payne Memorial Highway". The
13 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
14 bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

15 SECTION 9. AMENDATORY Section 3, Chapter 307, O.S.L.
16 2018 (69 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 1698.271), is amended to read as
17 follows:

18 Section 1698.271 The bridge on ~~U.S. Highway 283~~ Interstate 40
19 over the North Fork Red River ~~south of the municipal limits of~~ near
20 the town of Sayre in Beckham County shall be designated as the "SSG
21 Christopher ~~Michael~~ Michael Hake Memorial Bridge". The Department
22 of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing
23 that name to be placed on the bridge.

SECTION 10. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
