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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2011, Section 507, as
17	amended by Section 575, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (69 O.S. Supp.
18	2018, Section 507), is amended to read as follows:
19	Section 507. A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury
20	a revolving fund to be known as the "County Improvements for Roads
21	and Bridges Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject
22	to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all appropriations
23	and transfers made by the Legislature and the apportionments made
24	pursuant to subsection L of Section 1104 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma

1 Statutes. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby 2 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended beginning with the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008, and each fiscal year thereafter 3 4 pursuant to subsection B of this section. Expenditures from said 5 fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the 6 7 Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment. 8

9 Β. The funds apportioned pursuant to subsection L of Section 1104 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall be in equal amounts 10 11 to the various <del>Transportation Commission districts</del> counties. The 12 management and planning of these funds shall be controlled by the 13 Circuit Engineering District of which the county is a member. The 14 funds shall be used for the sole purpose of construction or 15 reconstruction of county roads or bridges on the county highway 16 system that are of the highest priority as defined by the 17 Transportation Commission. Counties may accumulate annual funding 18 for a period of up to five (5) years for a specific project, with 19 such funding to be held by the Transportation Commission to the 20 credit of the county project. The Transportation Commission shall 21 promulgate rules for the administration of the process and the 22 development of criteria for determining the level of priority for 23 projects and include such projects in a five-year construction plan 24 that will be updated annually. Projects in the five-year

construction plan shall be contracted as provided by law and awarded
by the Transportation Commission.

3	C. By resolution of the board of county commissioners of each
4	county, a county may opt out of the management of these funds by the
5	Circuit Engineering District and instruct the Oklahoma Tax
6	Commission to transmit those funds to the county treasurer to be
7	deposited in the county bridge and road improvement fund of that
8	<u>county.</u>
9	D. The fund shall be invested in whatever instruments are
10	authorized by law for investments by the State Treasurer and the
11	interest earned by any investment of monies from the fund shall be
12	credited to the fund which shall earn the same, if there is any
13	unexpended balance of such fund to which to credit the interest.
14	The interest credited herein shall be expended pursuant to this
15	section.
16	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
