of the fine, the court shall consider the severity of the violation,

- C. 1. Railroads or other persons, firms or corporations operating over tracks within the State of Oklahoma shall not block vehicle traffic at any railroad grade crossing for a period of time in excess of ten (10) minutes except if the train is moving in a continuous forward or backward direction, or if the train is stopped for an emergency condition, including an accident, derailment, critical mechanical failure, track or bridge washout, storm, flood or other emergency situation.
- 2. A one-time exception of up to, but not exceeding, ten (10) additional minutes shall be authorized under the following conditions:
  - a. when a train and its crew, operating under the rules of the Federal Railroad Administration (FRA), are unable to complete a switching maneuver while setting out or picking up rail cars within the ten (10) minutes as set forth in paragraph 1 of this subsection,
  - b. when a train is stopped to allow the passage of a second train and the stopped train has exhausted the ten (10) minutes as set forth in paragraph 1 of this

1 subsection, or if the arrival of the second train is 2 imminent and separation and coupling of the stopped 3 train would result in further unnecessary blocking of motor vehicle or pedestrian traffic, and 4 5 when a train is stopped for a red train signal. 6 3. When a train is cut or separated to prevent blocking of 7 motor vehicle traffic at a public crossing, and a working charging 8 station exists, the time required for recoupling a train and 9 performing air tests as required by the FRA shall not be considered 10 a violation of this section. 11 4. Every railroad shall be operated in such a manner as to 12 minimize obstruction of emergency vehicles at public highway grade 13 crossings. 14 SECTION 2.
