8 An Act relating to the Department of Transportation;
9 amending 69 O.S. 2011, Sections 302 and 305, which
10 relate to transportation; modifying appointment of
members of the Transportation Commission; authorizing
Governor to appoint the Director of the Department of
Transportation; and declaring an emergency.

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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2011, Section 302, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 302. ~~(a)~~ A. The State Transportation Commission shall
17 consist of an at-large member and one (1) member from each of eight
18 districts of the state, such districts to serve as the maintenance
19 districts and to include the area as follows:

20 District 1. Wagoner, Cherokee, Adair, Sequoyah, Muskogee,
21 Okmulgee, McIntosh and Haskell Counties.

22 District 2. Pittsburg, Latimer, LeFlore, McCurtain, Pushmataha,
23 Atoka, Choctaw, Bryan and Marshall Counties.

1 District 3. Lincoln, Cleveland, McClain, Garvin, Pottawatomie,
2 Okfuskee, Seminole, Hughes, Pontotoc, Coal and Johnston Counties.

3 District 4. Payne, Logan, Canadian, Kingfisher, Garfield,
4 Grant, Kay, Noble and Oklahoma Counties.

5 District 5. Roger Mills, Dewey, Custer, Washita, Beckham,
6 Greer, Kiowa, Harmon, Jackson, Blaine, and Tillman Counties.

7 District 6. Cimarron, Texas, Beaver, Harper, Woods, Alfalfa,
8 Ellis, Major and Woodward Counties.

9 District 7. Carter, Love, Murray, Grady, Comanche, Stephens,
10 Cotton, Caddo and Jefferson Counties.

11 District 8. Osage, Pawnee, Nowata, Creek, Craig, Ottawa,
12 Rogers, Mayes, Delaware, Washington and Tulsa Counties.

13 **(b) B.** The members of the Commission shall be appointed ~~by the~~
14 ~~Governor, by and with the consent of the Senate, such appointment to~~
15 ~~have full force and effect and to be submitted to the Senate for its~~
16 ~~confirmation at the first session of the Senate after such~~
17 ~~appointment is made. No Commissioner shall be entitled to the~~
18 ~~payment of salary, or to perform any service, until his appointment~~
19 ~~is confirmed by the Senate, if the Senate then be in session; if the~~
20 ~~Senate be not in session, then such Commissioner may serve and draw~~
21 ~~his salary until a special or regular session convenes; and if his~~
22 ~~appointment is not then confirmed within twenty (20) days, he shall~~
23 ~~cease to perform such services and cease to draw his salary. Each~~
24 ~~of the Commissioners thus appointed shall, at the time of his~~

1 appointment, be a citizen and resident of the district for which he
2 shall have been appointed for at least three (3) years prior to the
3 date of his appointment. Not more than one Commissioner shall
4 reside in any one district, as defined herein, at any time while
5 serving on the Commission. Each Commissioner thus appointed and
6 confirmed shall, after the first term of office as herein provided,
7 serve for a term of eight (8) years, and unless he is reappointed by
8 the Governor and confirmed by the Senate within twenty (20)
9 legislative days his services are automatically terminated and he
10 shall cease to draw his salary, or any perquisites or emoluments as
11 a Commissioner; provided, that in the event the Governor's appointee
12 is not confirmed by the Senate within ten (10) days from the date
13 his name is submitted, then the Governor shall submit a further
14 appointee for confirmation; and during his term of office may be
15 removed by the Governor at his pleasure. The terms of office shall
16 be as follows: Two Commissioners shall serve until the 15th day of
17 February, 1969; two Commissioners shall serve until the 15th day of
18 February, 1971; two Commissioners shall serve until the 15th day of
19 February, 1973; and two Commissioners shall serve until the 15th day
20 of February, 1975; and the Governor, at the time of making the first
21 appointment, shall, in his order of appointment, designate the term
22 each Commissioner so appointed shall serve. Thereafter the term of
23 each Commissioner appointed and confirmed shall expire the 15th day
24 of February in the eighth year after his appointment, and in case of

1 death, resignation, or removal, the place shall be filled by
2 appointment by the Governor for the remainder of the term. Such
3 appointments also shall be confirmed by the Senate. The members of
4 the Commission each shall receive an annual salary of Four Thousand
5 Eight Hundred Dollars (\$4,800.00), payable monthly, and each shall
6 be entitled to receive travel expenses pursuant to the State Travel
7 Reimbursement Act, Section 500.1 et seq. of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
8 Statutes as follows:

9 1. Members from Districts 5, 6, 7 and 8 and the at-large member
10 shall be appointed by the Governor;

11 2. Members from Districts 1 and 2 shall be appointed by the
12 Speaker of the House of Representatives; and

13 3. Members from Districts 3 and 4 shall be appointed by the
14 President Pro Tempore of the Senate.

15 C. Each member shall serve at the pleasure of his or her
16 appointing authority and may be removed or replaced without cause.

17 Any member of the Commission shall be prohibited from voting on any
18 issue in which the member has a direct financial interest. The
19 Governor Director of the Department of Transportation shall be an ex
20 officio member of the Commission, but shall be entitled to vote only
21 in case of a tie vote.

22 (c) Provided, that persons serving as members of the State
23 Highway Commission created by Section 301 of this title, when this
24 Code becomes effective shall serve as members of the State

1 Transportation Commission created by this Code for the remainder of
2 the terms for which they were appointed, in the positions on the
3 latter Commission having corresponding terms of office, or until
4 such positions are filled as herein provided. Future Gubernatorial
5 appointments shall be made from districts as directed by this act.

6 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2011, Section 305, is
7 amended to read as follows:

8 Section 305. There is hereby created the office of the Director
9 of the Department of Transportation, who shall be elected by a
10 majority vote of the entire Commission appointed by the Governor
11 with the advice and consent of the Senate and who shall serve at the
12 pleasure of the Commission. The Director shall receive an annual
13 salary to be fixed by a majority vote of the entire Commission from
14 appropriations made by the Legislature Governor and may be removed
15 or replaced without cause. Compensation for the Director shall be
16 determined by the Governor.

17 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
18 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
19 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
20 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
