11	An Act relating to the Department of Public Safety; providing certain authorizations; requiring that
12	portions of certain appropriated funds be used for certain purposes; authorizing requests for early
13	transfers of certain funds for specific purposes; providing for lapse of funds under certain
14	conditions; requiring certain budget procedures; prohibiting certain budget procedures; providing an
15	effective date; and declaring an emergency.
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18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
19	SECTION 1. Pursuant to Section 2-105.2 of Title 47 of the
20	Oklahoma Statutes, the Department of Public Safety is hereby
21	authorized to conduct up to two Oklahoma Highway Patrol Academies.
22	SECTION 2. The Department of Public Safety is hereby authorized
23	to use the proceeds of the sale of aircraft for the purpose
24	referenced in Section 1 of this act.

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SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Department of
Public Safety in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st Session of
the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, a sum of not less than Four Million
Dollars (\$4,000,000.00) shall be used for the purpose referenced in
Section 1 of this act.

SECTION 4. From the funds appropriated to the Department of 6 7 Public Safety in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Million Dollars 8 9 (\$1,000,000.00) shall be used for a communications system. 10 SECTION 5. From the funds appropriated to the Department of 11 Public Safety in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st Session of 12 the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$600,000.00) shall be used for a REAL ID compliant point-13 of-sale system. 14

15 SECTION 6. The Commissioner of Public Safety may request 16 through the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise 17 Services the early transfer by the Oklahoma Tax Commission of tax 18 collections to the General Revenue Fund for the purpose of early 19 allocation to the Department's disbursing funds to alleviate cash-20 flow problems.

21 SECTION 7. Appropriations made by Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 22 of the 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, not including 23 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for 24 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020 (hereafter FY-20), or may be

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1 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021 (hereafter FY-21). Funds budgeted for FY-20 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2 2020, and must be expended by November 15, 2020. Any funds 3 remaining after November 15, 2020, and not budgeted for FY-21, shall 4 5 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then-current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-21 may be encumbered only through June 6 7 30, 2021. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2021, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then-current fiscal year. 8 9 These appropriations shall not be budgeted in both fiscal years 10 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-20, and not required to pay 11 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-21, after 12 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds 13 from the FY-20 budget work program and after such revision has been 14 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services. 15 SECTION 8. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019. 16 SECTION 9.
