Amendment Cycle Extended

Secondary Amendment

1       A. A peer-to-peer car sharing program, a shared vehicle owner  
2 using a peer-to-peer car sharing program or a motor vehicle rental  
3 company shall, upon request of an airport including but not limited  
4 to any entity operating an airport pursuant to Section 65.5 of Title  
5 3 of the Oklahoma Statutes, or any entity owning or responsible for  
6 regulating or managing any public facility on public property within  
7 this state, enter into an agreement, which agreement may be a  
8 concession agreement, prior to:

9           1. Listing, publishing or advertising shared vehicles or other  
10 motor vehicles parked on or delivered to airport property or at  
11 airport facilities or other public facilities on public property;

12           2. Facilitating the use of shared vehicles or other motor  
13 vehicles to transport airport customers to or from airport property  
14 or airport facilities, or customers of other public facilities on  
15 public property, regardless of whether that use is to be initiated or  
16 has a start time which occurs on or off airport property or airport  
17 facilities or in other public facilities on public property; or

18           3. Promoting or marketing shared vehicles or other motor  
19 vehicles to transport airport customers to or from airport property  
20 or airport facilities, or customers of other public facilities on  
21 public property, regardless of whether that transportation is to be  
22 initiated or has a start time which occurs on or off airport property  
23 or airport facilities or other public facilities on public property.

24       B. The agreement specified in subsection A of this section shall  
set forth standards, regulations, procedures, and fees applicable to

1 peer-to-peer car sharing programs and motor vehicle rental companies  
2 for access to vehicle drivers that are airport customers, or  
3 customers of other public land or public facilities.

4 C. If the car sharing program, shared vehicle owner, or motor  
5 vehicle rental company:

6 1. Fails or refuses to enter into an agreement described in  
7 subsection A of this section after request by an airport or an entity  
8 owning or responsible for regulating or managing any public facility  
9 on public property; and

10 2. Performs, participates in, or undertakes any of the actions  
11 set forth in paragraph 1, 2 or 3 of subsection A of this section  
12 before entering into an agreement described in subsection A of this  
13 section after request by an airport,

14 then the affected airport or an entity owning or responsible for  
15 regulating or managing any public facility on public property may  
16 seek an injunction prohibiting operations at the airport or in public  
17 facilities on public property and may also seek damages against the  
18 peer-to-peer car sharing program, shared vehicle owner or motor  
19 vehicle rental company.

20 D. Record of the shared vehicle driver's address, license  
21 number, state of issuance of the driver license, the location where  
22 any shared vehicle driver was picked up, and where the car sharing  
23 location commenced shall be provided to an airport or a regulator or  
24 manager of any public facility on public property.
