A new section of law to be codified 16 NEW LAW in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-416 of Title 29, unless there 17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 18 Beginning in 2020, the Department of Wildlife Conservation 19 shall conduct experimental pronghorn antelope hunting seasons. 20 Landowners, or their designated agents, may determine the harvest 21 quota of pronghorn antelope and control the harvest of pronghorn 22 antelope on their property. The Department shall determine the 23

regions for the experimental pronghorn antelope hunting seasons on a county by county basis as the pronghorn antelope migrate.

- B. Hunters may obtain, at no cost, experimental pronghorn antelope permits at locations provided by the Department before harvesting pronghorn antelope during the experimental season.

 Hunters shall obtain the landowner or their designated agent's signature on the permit before harvesting pronghorn antelope.

 Hunters shall present their harvest at a mandatory check station, provided by the Department, within twenty-four (24) hours of harvest.
- C. The Department shall monitor the pronghorn antelope population during the experimental pronghorn antelope hunting seasons to ensure populations remain healthy. If a significant negative biological impact is observed, the Department shall end the experimental seasons.
- D. The Department shall promulgate rules to enforce the provisions of this act.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
