COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

[ public buildings - baby changing tables -  
codification - effective date ]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 334 of Title 61, unless there is  
created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

All new construction of state and municipal buildings open to  
the public commenced after January 1, 2022, and all renovations and  
replacements of existing public state and municipal buildings open  
to the public commenced after January 1, 2022, shall include at  
least one baby changing table. This section shall only apply to  
renovations and replacements if the renovation or replacement  
exceeds fifty percent (50%) of the value of the state or municipal  
building. If a baby changing table is not accessible in such a  
building or facility to both men and women, the building code shall

1 require that the building or facility be equipped with at least one  
2 such table accessible to men and at least one such table accessible  
3 to women.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
