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17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:								
18	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 73 O.S. 2011, Section 15.1, as								
19	last amended by Section 1, Chapter 335, O.S.L. 2016 (73 O.S. Supp.								
20	2018, Section 15.1), is amended to read as follows:								
21	Section 15.1 A. The Legislature shall have management and								
22	control of the following space on the ground, first, second, third,								
23	fourth, fifth and sixth floors in the State Capitol Building:								
24	1. The space on the third, fourth, fifth and sixth floors;								

2. Approximately one thousand five hundred eighty-five (1,585) square feet of space on the north side of the west wing of the basement;

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- 3. Approximately four thousand four hundred forty-six (4,446) square feet of space on the north side of the east wing of the basement;
- 4. Approximately four thousand seven hundred (4,700) square feet of space on the south side of the west wing of the basement;
- 5. Approximately two thousand sixty-nine (2,069) square feet of space on the east side of the north wing of the first floor;
- 6. Approximately fifteen thousand two hundred twenty (15,220) square feet of space on the north and south sides of the west wing of the first floor;
- 7. Approximately one hundred (100) square feet of space between the restrooms and the northwest stairwells and approximately one hundred (100) square feet of space between the restrooms and the northeast stairwells on the second, third, fourth and fifth floors; and
- 8. All space in the west wing of the second floor and all space in the north wing of the second floor that was occupied by the appellate courts prior to relocation to the Wiley Post Historical Building; provided, the Supreme Court shall continue to have exclusive management and control of the Supreme Court courtroom and designated robing room located in the west wing of the second floor.

B. The space under the management and control of the	
Legislature pursuant to the provisions of this section shall be	
allotted to the House of Representatives and Senate to be manage	ed
and controlled jointly as follows:	

- 1. Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, all space on the east side of the center of the State Capitol Building shall be occupied by the Senate and all space on the west side of the center of the State Capitol Building shall be occupied by the House of Representatives;
- 2. The space specified in paragraph 5 of subsection A of this section shall be occupied by the Legislative Service Bureau; and
- 3. All space in the north wings of the second, third and fifth floors, other than the space specified in paragraph 7 of subsection A of this section, shall be occupied by the Senate

The west wing of the basement, excluding existing House of

Representatives space, the Senate entrance and the Election Board;

- 2. The north wing of the basement;
- 3. The north wing of the first floor;
- 4. The south wing of the basement, excluding any entrances;
- 5. The east wing of the basement, excluding existing Senate

6. The center corridor of the basement;

7. The exterior veranda and the external staircase that provides access to the veranda on the west side of the Capitol Building;

- 8. The center corridor of the first floor, excluding all existing current Executive Branch, House of Representatives and Senate space;
 - 9. The south wing of the first floor, excluding any entrances;
- 10. The center corridor of the second floor, excluding all existing current Executive Branch, House of Representatives and Senate space;
 - 11. The south wing of the second floor;

- 12. The center corridor of the third floor, excluding all existing current House of Representatives and Senate space;
- 13. The center corridor of the fourth floor, excluding all existing current House of Representatives and Senate space;
- 14. The center corridor of the fifth floor, excluding all existing current House of Representatives and Senate space; and 15. The Dome.
- c. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall establish an enclosed vending area within the utility shafts accessible on the fourth floor of the State Capitol Building The space under the management and control of the Legislature pursuant to the provisions of this section shall be allotted to the House of Representatives as follows:

1	1. The west wing of the basement, excluding the entrance,								
2	shared space with the Senate, and the Election Board space;								
3	2. The west wing of the first floor;								
4	3. The east entrance of the east wing of the first floor;								
5	4. The west wing of the second floor, excluding the existing								
6	Supreme Court space;								
7	5. The west side of the north wing of the second floor,								
8	excluding existing Senate space;								
9	6. The west wing of the third floor;								
10	7. The west side of the north wing of the third floor,								
11	excluding existing Senate space;								
12	8. The west wing of the fourth floor;								
13	9. The west side of the north wing of the fourth floor;								
14	10. The west side of the south wing of the fourth floor;								
15	11. The west wing of the fifth floor;								
16	12. The west side of the south wing of the fifth floor;								
17	13. The west side of the north wing of the fifth floor,

19	14. The west wing of the sixth floor.								
20	D. The space under the management and control of the								
21	Legislature pursuant to the provisions of this section shall be								
22	allotted to the Senate as follows:								

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1. The east wing of the basement, excluding the shared space

with the House of Representatives;

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1	2.	The	west	entrance	of	the	west	wing	of	the	basement;
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- 3. The north wing of the second floor, excluding existing House

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- 4. The east wing of the third floor;
- 5. The north wing of the third floor, excluding existing House

 - 6. The east wing of the fourth floor;
 - 7. The east side of the north wing of the fourth floor;
 - 8. The east side of the south wing of the fourth floor;
 - 9. The east wing of the fifth floor;
- 11 10. The north wing of the fifth floor, excluding existing House
- 12 of Representatives space;
- 13 11. The east side of the south wing of the fifth floor; and
- 14 12. The east wing of the sixth floor.
- 15 E. The space under the management and control of the
- 16 Legislature pursuant to the provisions of this section shall be
- 17 | allotted to the Executive Branch as follows:
- 18 1. The east wing of the first floor, excluding the east
- 19 entrance; and
- 20 2. The east wing of the second floor.
- 21 F. Any space not designated in this section shall be under the
- 22 management and control of the House of Representatives and the
- 23 | Senate. Any references to "existing" or "current" space allocations
- 24 | in subsection A, B, C, D or E of this section shall be defined

pursuant to those certain maps or drawings filed with the Secretary of State pursuant to the provisions of this section and which were executed November 16, 2016.

- <u>G.</u> The authority of the Legislature to allot space may be delegated to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives. Any allotment other than as provided <u>for</u> in this section shall be executed pursuant to a written agreement signed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
- E. H. Each House of the State Legislature shall have the exclusive charge of the purchase, use, allotment and disposition of its respective chambers, committee rooms, fixtures, furniture, supplies and apparatus, and shall be responsible for the use and preservation of same.
- F. I. The provisions of this section shall not prohibit the Legislature from allowing agencies of the executive or judicial departments to use space within the State Capitol Building that is under its management and control pursuant to a written agreement signed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
- G. The J. Upon the effective date of this act, and as necessary upon the completion of construction or renovation projects, the Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall cause to be created a comprehensive set of architectural drawings

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reflecting the physical layout of the Capitol spaces allocated to
the Legislature pursuant to this section. The President Pro Tempore
of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall
review and certify the architectural drawings created pursuant to
this subsection. The certification required by this subsection
shall be accomplished by the signature of each such officer upon the
face of the drawings. Upon certification, such architectural
drawings shall become the official record of the spaces allocated to
the Legislature within the State Capitol Building. The Secretary of
State shall attest the signatures required by this subsection and
the signed and attested architectural drawings shall be deposited
with the State Archivist, as defined in Section 204 of Title 67 of
the Oklahoma Statutes. The State Archivist shall hold the signed
and attested architectural drawings as an official record of the
State of Oklahoma. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services
shall provide two copies of the signed and attested architectural
drawings to the Secretary of the Senate and two copies to the Clerk
of the House of Representatives.
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SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
