A new section of law not to be 12 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows: 13 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Electric Cooperative Pole Attachment Partnership Act". 14 A new section of law to be codified 15 SECTION 2. NEW LAW in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 158.65 of Title 17, unless there 16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 17 Upon request, any rural electric cooperative shall provide 18 the formula by which they calculate a pole attachment rate to any 19 entity that pays to attach to a pole owned by the rural electric 20 cooperative within a reasonable time period. This information shall 21 include each component of the formula and a description of the 22 specific costs the particular component of the formula includes with 23 24

1	as much detail as practical without disclosing proprietary
2	information.
3	B. Nothing in this act shall be construed as requiring a rural
4	electric cooperative to list the exact costs in dollars of each
5	component of the formula. The rural electric cooperative shall
6	include the total cost per attachment, as determined by the formula.
7	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
