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6 An Act relating to the Oklahoma State University
7 Medical Authority; requiring that portions of certain
8 appropriated funds be used for certain purposes;
9 requiring certain transition payments be used for
10 stated purposes; authorizing requests for early
11 transfers of certain funds for specific purposes;
12 providing for lapse of funds under certain
13 conditions; requiring certain budget procedures;
14 prohibiting certain budget procedures; providing an
15 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma State
18 University Medical Authority in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the
19 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, One Million Five
20 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000.00) shall be used for medical
21 school certification.

22 SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma State
23 University Medical Authority in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the
24 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, One Million Dollars
(\$1,000,000.00) shall be used to enhance physician recruitment.

SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma State
University Medical Authority in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the

1 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, Twenty-eight Million
2 Nine Hundred Twenty-seven Thousand One Hundred Forty-one Dollars
3 (\$28,927,141.00) shall be used for duties including the Oklahoma
4 State University Dean's GME Program.

5 SECTION 4. The Oklahoma State University Center for Health
6 Sciences shall ensure that in addition to funding the Dean's GME
7 Program for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, funds received
8 pursuant to Section 3 of this act in combination with funds received
9 from the Dean's GME transition payments for the fiscal year ending
10 June 30, 2019, are used to:

11 1. Reimburse the Oklahoma Health Care Authority an amount equal
12 to the proportionate share of Oklahoma State University Center for
13 Health Sciences' Dean's GME program disallowance for each of the
14 four quarters of the state fiscal year ending June 30, 2020; and

15 2. Budget an additional Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000.00)
16 for the construction of a new building which will also serve as the
17 Tulsa location for the the Board of Medicolegal Investigations.

18 SECTION 5. The CEO of the Oklahoma State University Medical
19 Authority may request through the Director of the Office of
20 Management and Enterprise Services the early transfer by the
21 Oklahoma Tax Commission of tax collections to the General Revenue
22 Fund for the purpose of early allocation to the Authority's
23 disbursing funds to alleviate cash-flow problems.

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1 SECTION 6. Appropriations made by Enrolled House Bill No. 2765
2 of the 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, not including
3 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
4 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020 (hereafter FY-20), or may be
5 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021 (hereafter FY-21).
6 Funds budgeted for FY-20 may be encumbered only through June 30,
7 2020, and must be expended by November 15, 2020. Any funds
8 remaining after November 15, 2020, and not budgeted for FY-21, shall
9 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then-current fiscal
10 year. Funds budgeted for FY-21 may be encumbered only through June
11 30, 2021. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2021, shall lapse
12 to the credit of the proper fund for the then-current fiscal year.
13 These appropriations shall not be budgeted in both fiscal years
14 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-20, and not required to pay
15 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-21, after
16 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
17 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
18 from the FY-20 budget work program and after such revision has been
19 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

20 SECTION 7. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.

21 SECTION 8. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
22 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
23 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
24 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
