1 ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 1043 By: Thompson and Rader of the 2 Senate and 3 Wallace and Hilbert of the House 4 5 6 An Act relating to the Oklahoma State University Medical Authority; requiring that portions of certain 7 appropriated funds be used for certain purposes; requiring certain transition payments be used for stated purposes; authorizing requests for early 8 transfers of certain funds for specific purposes; 9 providing for lapse of funds under certain conditions; requiring certain budget procedures; prohibiting certain budget procedures; providing an 10 effective date; and declaring an emergency. 11 12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA: 13 From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma State 14 SECTION 1. 15 University Medical Authority in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, One Million Five 16 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000.00) shall be used for medical 17 school certification. 18 SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma State 19 University Medical Authority in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 20 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, One Million Dollars 21 (\$1,000,000.00) shall be used to enhance physician recruitment. 22

SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma State

2 Nine Hundred Twenty-seven Thousand One Hundred Forty-one Dollars
3 (\$28,927,141.00) shall be used for duties including the Oklahoma

State University Dean's GME Program.

- SECTION 4. The Oklahoma State University Center for Health
 Sciences shall ensure that in addition to funding the Dean's GME
 Program for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, funds received
 pursuant to Section 3 of this act in combination with funds received
 from the Dean's GME transition payments for the fiscal year ending
 June 30, 2019, are used to:
- 1. Reimburse the Oklahoma Health Care Authority an amount equal to the proportionate share of Oklahoma State University Center for Health Sciences' Dean's GME program disallowance for each of the four quarters of the state fiscal year ending June 30, 2020; and
- 2. Budget an additional Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000.00) for the construction of a new building which will also serve as the Tulsa location for the Board of Medicolegal Investigations.
- SECTION 5. The CEO of the Oklahoma State University Medical
 Authority may request through the Director of the Office of
 Management and Enterprise Services the early transfer by the
 Oklahoma Tax Commission of tax collections to the General Revenue
 Fund for the purpose of early allocation to the Authority's
 disbursing funds to alleviate cash-flow problems.

SECTION 6. Appropriations made by Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020 (hereafter FY-20), or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021 (hereafter FY-21). Funds budgeted for FY-20 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2020, and must be expended by November 15, 2020. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2020, and not budgeted for FY-21, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then-current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-21 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2021. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2021, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then-current fiscal year. These appropriations shall not be budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-20, and not required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-21, after the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds from the FY-20 budget work program and after such revision has been approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

SECTION 7. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.

SECTION 8. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
