7 An Act relating to the State Department of
8 Rehabilitation Services; requiring that portions of
9 certain appropriated funds be used for certain
10 purposes; prohibiting supplantation of funding;
11 requiring a certain amount of funding to be budgeted
12 for a stated purpose; authorizing requests for early
13 transfers of certain funds for specific purposes;
14 providing for lapse of funds under certain conditions
15 requiring certain budget procedures; prohibiting
16 certain budget procedures; providing an effective
17 date; and declaring an emergency.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Department of
20 Rehabilitation Services in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st
21 Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Nine Hundred
22 Ninety-two Thousand Eight Hundred Nineteen Dollars (\$992,819.00)
23 shall be used for the maintenance of effort for Visual Services and
24 Vocational Rehabilitation.

SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Department of
Rehabilitation Services in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st
Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Two Million

1 Five Hundred Nine Thousand Two Hundred Ninety-three Dollars
2 (\$2,509,293.00) shall be used for capital improvements at the
3 Oklahoma School for the Deaf located in Sulphur, Oklahoma.

4 SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Department of
5 Rehabilitation Services in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st
6 Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Hundred
7 Fifty-six Thousand Dollars (\$156,000.00) shall be used for the
8 maintenance of the Oklahoma School for the Blind located in
9 Muskogee, Oklahoma. These funds shall not supplant current
10 maintenance funding and the agency shall budget no less than the
11 total of the amount budgeted in the fiscal year ending June 30,
12 2019, plus the amount listed above for this purpose.

13 SECTION 4. From the funds appropriated to the Department of
14 Rehabilitation Services in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st
15 Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Hundred
16 Ninety-two Thousand Dollars (\$192,000.00) shall be used for the
17 maintenance of the Oklahoma School for the Deaf located in Sulphur,
18 Oklahoma. These funds shall not supplant current maintenance
19 funding and the agency shall budget no less than the total of the
20 amount budgeted in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, plus the
21 amount listed above for this purpose.

22 SECTION 5. From the funds appropriated to the Department of
23 Rehabilitation Services in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st
24 Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Ninety-one

1 Thousand Three Hundred Thirty-three Dollars (\$91,333.00) shall be
2 used for the teacher pay raise.

3 SECTION 6. The Director of the State Department of
4 Rehabilitation Services may request through the Director of the
5 Office of Management and Enterprise Services the early transfer by
6 the Oklahoma Tax Commission of tax collections to the General
7 Revenue Fund for the purpose of early allocation to the Department's
8 disbursing funds to alleviate cash-flow problems.

9 SECTION 7. Appropriations made by Enrolled House Bill No. 2765
10 of the 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, not including
11 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
12 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020 (hereafter FY-20), or may be
13 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021 (hereafter FY-21).
14 Funds budgeted for FY-20 may be encumbered only through June 30,
15 2020, and must be expended by November 15, 2020. Any funds
16 remaining after November 15, 2020, and not budgeted for FY-21, shall
17 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then-current fiscal
18 year. Funds budgeted for FY-21 may be encumbered only through June
19 30, 2021. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2021, shall lapse
20 to the credit of the proper fund for the then-current fiscal year.
21 These appropriations shall not be budgeted in both fiscal years
22 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-20, and not required to pay
23 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-21, after
24 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared

1 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
2 from the FY-20 budget work program and after such revision has been
3 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

4 SECTION 8. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.

5 SECTION 9. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
6 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
7 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
8 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
