7 An Act relating to the Department of Human Services;
8 creating a revolving fund; providing that the fund
9 shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations;
10 describing sources of funding; directing the Director
11 of the Department of Human Services to provide a
12 monthly report to the Senate Appropriations Chair and
13 the House Appropriations and Budget Chair; stating
14 contents of the report; providing that all monies
15 accruing to the credit of the fund are appropriated
16 and shall be budgeted and expended by the Departments
17 only at the direction of the Legislature; stating
18 allowable uses for the fund; requiring certain
19 procedures for expenditures from the fund; providing
20 for codification; and declaring an emergency.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 229.1 of Title 56, unless there
24 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
for the Department of Human Services to be designated the
"Department of Human Services Infrastructure Revolving Fund". The
fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year
limitations, and shall consist of all monies designated to the fund

1 by law. The Director of the Department of Human Services shall, at
2 the end of each month, provide a current balance and statement of
3 encumbrances of the fund to the Chair of the Appropriations
4 Committee of the Senate and the Chair of the Committee on
5 Appropriations and Budget of the House of Representatives. All
6 monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated
7 and shall only be budgeted and expended at the direction of the
8 Oklahoma Legislature. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon
9 warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as
10 prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and
11 Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

12 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
13 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
14 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
15 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
