7 An Act relating to the Department of Human Services;
8 creating a revolving fund; providing that the fund
9 shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations;
10 describing sources of funding; directing the Director
11 of the Department of Human Services to provide a
12 monthly report to the Senate Appropriations Chair and
13 the House Appropriations and Budget Chair; stating
14 contents of the report; providing that all monies
15 accruing to the credit of the fund are appropriated
16 and may be budgeted and expended by the Department;
17 stating allowable uses for the fund; requiring
18 certain procedures for expenditures from the fund;
19 providing for codification; and declaring an
20 emergency.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 229 of Title 56, unless there is
24 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
for the Department of Human Services to be designated the "OK
Benefits Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not
subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies
designated to the fund by law. The Director of the Department of

1 Human Services shall, at the end of each month, provide a current
2 balance and statement of encumbrances of the fund to the Chair of
3 the Senate Appropriations Committee and the Chair of the House of
4 Representatives Committee on Appropriations and Budget. All monies
5 accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may
6 be budgeted and expended by the Department of Human Services for the
7 sole purpose of the acquisition, operation, maintenance, repair and
8 replacement of the OK Benefits system at the Department of Human
9 Services. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants
10 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by
11 law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
12 Services for approval and payment.

13 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
14 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
15 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
16 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
