7 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Historical Society;
8 requiring that portions of certain appropriated funds
9 be used for certain purposes; providing an effective
10 date; and declaring an emergency.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
13 Historical Society in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st
14 Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, not less than Seventy
15 Thousand Dollars (\$70,000.00) shall be used to provide for the Will
16 Rogers Memorial Museum. These funds shall be used to provide
17 additional funding for the Will Rogers Memorial Museum and shall be
18 used to supplement rather than replace existing resources.

19 SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
20 Historical Society in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st
21 Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Million
22 Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000.00) shall be transferred
23 to the 1921 Tulsa Race Riot Centennial Memorial Revolving Fund
24 created in Section 8207 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

1 SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
2 Historical Society in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st
3 Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, not less than Six Hundred
4 Thousand Dollars (\$600,000.00) shall be used to provide for roof and
5 structure rehabilitation of the Oklahoma History Center.

6 SECTION 4. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
7 Historical Society in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st
8 Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, not less than Two Hundred
9 Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) shall be used to provide for
10 the Stafford Air and Space Museum. These funds shall be used to
11 provide additional funding for the Stafford Air and Space Museum and
12 shall be used to supplement rather than replace existing resources.

13 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.

14 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
15 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
16 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
17 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
