6 An Act relating to driver licenses; amending 47 O.S.  
7 2011, Section 6-121, which relates to extension of  
8 driver licenses; modifying qualifying persons for  
9 extensions; and providing an effective date.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 6-121, is  
12 amended to read as follows:

13 Section 6-121. A. Any person who is in the custody of the  
14 Department of Corrections and incarcerated within a facility of the  
15 Department and who holds a valid Class D driver license, issued by  
16 the State of Oklahoma for the operation of motor vehicles upon the  
17 highways of this state, upon entry into custody shall not be  
18 considered to have an expired Class D driver license for the  
19 duration of such incarceration, not to exceed three (3) years, and  
20 for a period of sixty (60) days from and after the release of the  
21 person from such period of incarceration. This law shall not be  
22 construed to confer driving privileges in any other jurisdiction  
23 other than Oklahoma.

24 B. Any person or the spouse or dependent of a person:

1        1. Who is on active duty with the Armed Forces of the United  
2 States; or

3        2. Who is currently employed as a civilian contractor with the  
4 Armed Forces of the United States, living outside of Oklahoma and  
5 having a valid driver license issued by the State of Oklahoma for  
6 the operation of motor vehicles upon the highways of this state

7        shall not be considered to have an expired driver license for  
8 the duration of such service or employment and for a period of sixty  
9 (60) days from and after the return of the person or the spouse or  
10 dependent of the person to Oklahoma from such service or employment.  
11 This law shall not be construed to confer driving privileges in any  
12 jurisdiction other than Oklahoma.

13        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
