The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for 16 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law, the following proposed amendment to the Oklahoma Constitution by 17 adding a new Section 7A to Article II to read as follows: 18 Section 7A. A. Nothing in this Constitution secures or 19 protects the right to perform or receive an abortion, nor shall any 20 provision of this Constitution be construed to preclude, invalidate 21

or in any way limit, a statute that prohibits abortion, regulates

abortion or regulates abortion differently from other acts or

procedures.

B. As used in this section, "abortion" means the use or prescription of any instrument, medicine, drug or other substance or device intentionally to terminate a pregnancy other than to increase the probability of a live birth, to preserve the life or health of the child after live birth, to remove an ectopic pregnancy or to remove an unborn child who died as the result of a spontaneous miscarriage, accidental trauma or a criminal assault on the pregnant female or her unborn child.

SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in the following form:

BALLOT TITLE

Legislative Referendum No. ____ State Question No. ____ THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

This measure adds a new Section 7A to Article 2 of the Oklahoma Constitution. The proposed Section 7A states that nothing in the Oklahoma Constitution secures or protects the right to perform or receive an abortion. The proposed Section 7A also states that nothing in the Oklahoma Constitution may be read to prevent statutes from being enacted that prohibit abortion, regulate abortion or regulate abortion differently from other acts or procedures. "Abortion" is defined for the purposes of this proposed Section 7A as the use or prescription of any instrument, drug or device intentionally to terminate a

1 pregnancy. The measure exempts from this definition terminating a pregnancy for certain reasons, such as to preserve the life or 2 3 health of an unborn child, to remove an ectopic pregnancy or to remove an unborn child who died as the result of a spontaneous 4 5 miscarriage, accidental trauma or a criminal assault on a pregnant woman or her unborn child. This measure concerns only 6 the rights guaranteed by the Oklahoma Constitution. It would 7 not alter any rights guaranteed by the United States 8 9 Constitution. 10 SHALL THE PROPOSAL BE APPROVED? 11 FOR THE PROPOSAL - YES 12 AGAINST THE PROPOSAL - NO 13 SECTION 3.
