11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
12	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 2011, Section 6-282, is
13	amended to read as follows:
14	Section 6-282. As used in <del>this act</del> <u>Section 6-281 et seq. of</u>
15	this title unless the context otherwise requires:
16	1. "Equine infectious anemia" or "EIA" means the communicable,
17	infectious disease which affects only equidae and is caused by the
18	virus of equine infectious anemia;
19	2. "Board" means the <del>Oklahoma</del> State Board of Agriculture;
20	3. "Equidae" means a family of perissodactyl ungulate mammals
21	containing a single genus, Equus, which includes horses, asses,
22	jacks, jennies, hinnies, mules, donkeys, burros, ponies and zebras;
23	4. "Official test" means <del>the Agar-Gel Immunodiffusion (AGID)</del> <u>a</u>

test for equine infectious anemia which has been conducted in a

1	laboratory approved by the Board $\frac{\partial}{\partial r}$ and the United States Department
2	of Agriculture for the purpose of conducting this test or any other
3	test or examination for the detection of equine infectious anemia
4	approved by the Department; and
5	5. "Reactor" means any equidae which discloses a positive
6	reaction to an official test for equine infectious anemia.
7	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
