14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 9010 of Title 62, unless there
17	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	A. Financial presentations as prescribed by the State Auditor
19	and Inspector completed by any agency, board, commission, department
20	or program in the executive branch of state government shall be
21	signed and attested as to the accuracy of the statements by the
22	chief executive officer and the chief financial officer.
23	R Each agency board commission department or program in the

executive branch of state government shall report its fiscal year

financial information on a form prescribed by the State Auditor and The form shall include the following attestation to be Inspector. signed by the chief financial officer and chief executive officer: "I attest the above-presented financial information is complete and true to the best of my knowledge and all financial records have been accurately reconciled to the financial records of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services." The financial form described in this subsection shall be completed within one hundred twenty (120) days of the close of the fiscal year and submitted to the Office of State Auditor and Inspector. The State Auditor and Inspector shall review the form for proper completion and may return the form to the entity until properly completed. Appropriations shall not be considered for the subsequent fiscal year until the form has been approved by the State Auditor and Inspector. agency that files an independent audit report with the State Auditor and Inspector annually within one hundred twenty (120) days of the end of the fiscal year shall be exempt from the provisions of this subsection.

C. Making, providing or submitting any false, fictitious or fraudulent financial information on the form provided in subsection B of this section, or knowing such information to be false, fictitious or fraudulent, shall subject the chief executive officer and chief financial officer to immediate removal from office and the penalties provided by subsection D of this section.

1	D. Any person violating the provisions of this section shall,
2	upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of
3	Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00), or imprisonment in a county jail

5	E. The requirements of this section shall not replace or negate
6	the financial reporting requirements established by Section 34.10 of
