6 An Act relating to elections; amending 26 O.S. 2011,
7 Section 4-101, which relates to voter registration;
8 clarifying conditions for voter eligibility; and
9 providing an effective date.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 4-101, is
12 amended to read as follows:

13 Section 4-101. Every person who is a qualified elector as
14 defined by Section 1 of Article III of the Oklahoma Constitution
15 shall be entitled to become a registered voter in the precinct of
16 his or her residence, with the following ~~exceptions~~ conditions:

17 1. Persons convicted of a felony shall be ~~ineligible~~ eligible
18 ~~to register for a period of time equal to the time prescribed in the~~
19 ~~judgment and sentence.~~ to vote when they have fully served their
20 sentence of court-mandated calendar days, including any term of
21 incarceration, parole or supervision, or completed a period of
22 probation ordered by any court; and

23 2. Any person who has been adjudged to be an incapacitated
24 person as such term is defined by Section 1-111 of Title 30 of the

1 Oklahoma Statutes⁷ shall be ineligible to register to vote. When
2 such incapacitated person has been adjudged to be no longer
3 incapacitated such person shall be eligible to become a registered
4 voter. The provisions of this paragraph shall not prohibit any
5 person adjudged to be a partially incapacitated person as such term
6 is defined by Section 1-111 of Title 30 of the Oklahoma Statutes
7 from being eligible to register to vote unless the order adjudging
8 the person to be partially incapacitated restricts such ~~persons~~
9 person from being eligible to register to vote.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
