Every person who is a qualified elector as 14 defined by Section 1 of Article III of the Oklahoma Constitution 15 shall be entitled to become a registered voter in the precinct of 16 his or her residence, with the following exceptions conditions: 17 1. Persons convicted of a felony shall be ineligible eligible 18 to register for a period of time equal to the time prescribed in the 19 judgment and sentence. to vote when they have fully served their 20 sentence of court-mandated calendar days, including any term of 21 incarceration, parole or supervision, or completed a period of 22 probation ordered by any court; and 23 2. Any person who has been adjudged to be an incapacitated 24 person as such term is defined by Section 1-111 of Title 30 of the

2	such incapacitated person has been adjudged to be no longer
3	incapacitated such person shall be eligible to become a registered
4	voter. The provisions of this paragraph shall not prohibit any

6	is defined by Section 1-111 of Title 30 of the Oklahoma Statutes
7	from being eligible to register to vote unless the order adjudging
8	the person to be partially incapacitated restricts such persons
9	person from being eligible to register to vote.
