10 An Act relating to transportation funding; making an
11 appropriation to the County Improvements for Roads
and Bridges Fund; stating amount; identifying source;
12 stating purpose; providing for noncodification;
providing an effective date; and declaring an
13 emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
18 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

19 There is hereby appropriated to the County Improvements for
20 Roads and Bridges Fund created pursuant to Section 507 of Title 69
21 of the Oklahoma Statutes from any monies not otherwise appropriated
22 from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal
23 year ending June 30, 2020, the sum of Thirty Million Dollars
24 (\$30,000,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary for any

1 purpose authorized by subsection B of Section 507 of Title 69 of the
2 Oklahoma Statutes.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.

4 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
