8 An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S.  
9 2011, Section 11-403.1, which relates to failure to  
10 yield causing fatality or serious bodily injury;  
11 modifying certain fee; allowing court to impose  
12 certain additional penalties; and providing an  
13 effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 11-403.1, is  
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 11-403.1 A. Any person convicted of failure to yield a  
18 right-of-way and who causes a fatality or serious bodily injury as a  
19 result of such violation ~~may~~ shall, in addition to any other fine or  
20 penalty, be assessed a fee in ~~an~~ the amount ~~not exceeding One~~  
21 ~~Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00)~~ of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) to be  
22 deposited in the Motorcycle Safety and Education Program Revolving  
23 Fund established in Section 40-123 of this title. The monies  
24 deposited as provided in this ~~section~~ subsection shall be used to  
promote public awareness of the dangers of driving while under the

1 influence of alcohol or any controlled substance and to promote  
2 motorcycle safety and defensive driving for youth.

3 B. In addition to the fee listed in subsection A of this  
4 section, the court may impose additional penalties, including:

- 5 1. A remedial driving course;  
6 2. A loss of driver license for ninety (90) days; or  
7 3. A payment of restitution of no less than Three Thousand  
8 Dollars (\$3,000.00), but no more than Ten Thousand Dollars  
9 (\$10,000.00).

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
