An Act relating to the Oklahoma Historical Society;
requiring that portions of certain appropriated funds
be used for certain purposes; providing an effective
date; and declaring an emergency.

SUBJECT: Oklahoma Historical Society

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Historical Society in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, not less than Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$70,000.00) shall be used to provide for the Will Rogers Memorial Museum. These funds shall be used to provide additional funding for the Will Rogers Memorial Museum and shall be used to supplement rather than replace existing resources.

SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Historical Society in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000.00) shall be transferred to the 1921 Tulsa Race Riot Centennial Memorial Revolving Fund created in Section 8207 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Historical Society in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, not less than Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$600,000.00) shall be used to provide for roof and structure rehabilitation of the Oklahoma History Center.

SECTION 4. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Historical Society in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, not less than Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) shall be used to provide for the Stafford Air and Space Museum. These funds shall be used to provide additional funding for the Stafford Air and Space Museum and shall be used to supplement rather than replace existing resources.

SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.

SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
