An Act relating to holidays; amending 25 O.S. 2011,
Section 90.12, which relates to Oklahoma Native
American Day; changing date of designation; and
providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: Oklahoma Native American Day

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 25 O.S. 2011, Section 90.12, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 90.12. The ~~Third~~ second Monday in ~~November~~ October of
each year is designated as "Oklahoma Native American Day" in
Oklahoma. All citizens of this state are requested to devote some
portion of Oklahoma Native American Day to commemorate the
accomplishments of Oklahoma's Native Americans. Teachers and
students of the schools of this state are requested to observe the
day with appropriate activities.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 2019.
