1 "SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1205, is 2 amended to read as follows: Section 1205. It shall be unlawful for any person to throw or 3 leave or deposit garbage, tin cans, junk, rubbish or refuse and 4 5 other items and matters commonly referred to as trash within one hundred (100) yards of any state highway or any county road or the 6 occupied dwelling of another, except when the placement of such 7 materials is along a collection route for the specific intent and 8 9 purpose of scheduled collection and transportation to a recycling or 10 disposal facility serving the area. Provided, however, that any city or town operating or desiring to operate a solid waste disposal 11 12 site within the distance above prescribed may establish said solid 13 waste disposal site when said solid waste disposal site is approved 14 by the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality. 15 SECTION 2. 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1206, is AMENDATORY 16 amended to read as follows: 17 Section 1206. Any person or any officer of any city or town 18 violating any of the provisions of this act shall, upon conviction, 19 be fined not more less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) Two 20 Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars 21 (\$500.00), or be imprisoned in the county jail for not more than 22 thirty (30) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment." 23 24 57-1-8119 02/20/19 GRS
