15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1290.9, as
16	last amended by Section 2, Chapter 4, O.S.L. 2017 (21 O.S. Supp.
17	2018, Section 1290.9), is amended to read as follows:
18	Section 1290.9.
19	ELIGIBILITY
20	The following requirements shall apply to any person making
21	application to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation for a
22	handgun license pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-
23	Defense Act. The person must:

1. Be a citizen of the United States $\underline{\text{with established residency}}$ in the State of Oklahoma; or

2. Establish a residency Be a lawful permanent resident in the United States and have established residency in the State of Oklahoma.

For purposes of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act, the:

- a. the term "residency" shall apply to any person who either possesses a valid Oklahoma driver license or state photo identification card, and physically maintains a residence in this state or to any person, including the spouse of such person, who has permanent military orders within this state and possesses a valid driver license from another state where such person and spouse of such person claim residency, and
- b. the term "lawful permanent resident" shall mean a noncitizen who is lawfully authorized to live permanently within the United States;

3. Be at least:

- a. twenty-one (21) years of age, or
- b. eighteen (18) years of age but not yet twenty-one (21) years of age and the person is a member or veteran of the United States Armed Forces, the Reserves or National Guard, or the person was discharged under

1	honorable conditions from the United States Armed
2	Forces, Reserves or National Guard;
3	4. Complete a firearms safety and training course and
4	demonstrate competence and qualifications with the type of pistol to
5	be carried by the person as provided in Section 1290.14 of this
6	title, and submit proof of training and qualification or an
7	exemption for training and qualification as authorized by Section
8	1290.14 of this title;
9	5. Submit the required fee and complete the application process
10	as provided in Section 1290.12 of this title; and
11	6. Comply in good faith with the provisions of the Oklahoma
12	Self-Defense Act.
13	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
