12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 9100 of Title 74, unless there  
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. There is hereby created, until September 30, 2021, a task  
17 force to study, evaluate and make recommendations concerning the  
18 possible unification options of state public safety agencies within  
19 this state. The task force shall also study, evaluate and make  
20 recommendations regarding standardized data collections and  
21 integration, data systems and operational boundaries for state  
22 public safety agencies. The task force shall also study, evaluate  
23 and make recommendations regarding development of a focused, common  
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1 training and leadership development program for all members of state  
2 public safety agencies.

3 B. The task force shall be composed of the following seventeen  
4 (17) members:

5 1. The Commissioner of the Department of Public Safety or  
6 designee;

7 2. The Director of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation  
8 or designee;

9 3. The Director of the Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and  
10 Dangerous Drugs or designee;

11 4. The Executive Director of the Council on Law Enforcement  
12 Education and Training or designee;

13 5. The State Fire Marshal or designee;

14 6. The Director of the ABLE Commission or designee;

15 7. The Cabinet Secretary of Public Safety or designee;

16 8. The Chief of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol or designee;

17 9. The Attorney General or designee;

18 10. Two members appointed by the Speaker of the House of  
19 Representatives, one who shall be an elected member of the House of  
20 Representatives;

21 11. Two members appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the  
22 Senate, one who shall be an elected member of the Senate;

23 12. One member appointed by the Oklahoma Sheriffs' Association  
24 who shall be a sheriff of a county with a population under twenty-

1 five thousand (25,000), as determined by the latest Federal  
2 Decennial Census;

3 13. One member appointed by the Oklahoma Sheriffs' Association  
4 who shall be a sheriff of a county with a population over twenty-  
5 five thousand (25,000), as determined by the latest Federal  
6 Decennial Census;

7 14. One member appointed by the Oklahoma Association of Police  
8 Chiefs who shall be a chief of police representing a municipality  
9 with a population over ten thousand (10,000), as determined by the  
10 latest Federal Decennial Census; and

11 15. One member appointed by the Oklahoma Association of Police  
12 Chiefs who shall be a chief of police representing a municipality  
13 with a population under ten thousand (10,000), as determined by the  
14 latest Federal Decennial Census.

15 C. The two appointed members of the Legislature shall serve as  
16 co-chairs of the task force. A majority of the members shall  
17 constitute a quorum for the purpose of conducting the business of  
18 the task force. The task force shall meet as often as may be  
19 required in order to perform the duties imposed upon it. The chair  
20 shall call the first meeting and all subsequent meetings shall be  
21 made at the call of the chair.

22 D. Members of the task force shall receive no compensation or  
23 travel reimbursement.

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1 E. The meetings of the task force shall be subject to the  
2 Oklahoma Open Meeting Act.

3 F. The task force shall prepare a report of its findings and  
4 recommendations to be submitted to the Legislature no later than  
5 August 1, 2021.

6 G. Staffing for the task force shall be provided by the  
7 Governor's office, the Senate and the House of Representatives.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective in accordance with  
9 the provisions of Section 58 of Article V of the Oklahoma  
10 Constitution.
