1 SECTION 18. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-756 of Title 63, unless there
3 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 Unborn children in this state shall receive the equal protection
5 of the laws of this state and of the United States Constitution to

1 establish that a living human child, from the moment of fertilization
2 upon the fusion of a human spermatozoon with a human ovum, is
3 entitled to the same rights, powers, privileges, justice and
4 protections as are secured or granted by the laws of this state to
5 any other human person.

6 SECTION 19. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
7 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-757 of Title 63, unless there
8 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

9 Pursuant to Article II, Sections 2 and 7 of the Constitution of
10 the State of Oklahoma and Amendment V of the United States
11 Constitution, the State of Oklahoma shall protect the life, liberty
12 and property of all human life within its boundaries. This state is
13 granted such powers through Article X of the United States
14 Constitution as a reserved power. As abortion is not a reserved
15 power in the United States Constitution, the sovereign State of
16 Oklahoma shall protect all human life from conception to natural
17 death. As provided in Amendment XIV of the United States
18 Constitution, a citizen is naturalized at the moment of conception,
19 and unborn humans are hereby from the moment of conception
20 naturalized by the State of Oklahoma through the equal protection and
21 due process provisions of Amendment XIV of the United States
22 Constitution. Unborn children's lives shall be protected equally by
23 the sovereign State of Oklahoma, and such unborn children shall
24 reserve all rights as citizens of the sovereign State of Oklahoma.

1 United States Constitution, no individual or organization shall be
2 allowed to perform an abortion of a human being in the State of
3 Oklahoma. As used in this section, "naturalization" means the
4 quality of being brought into conformity with nature.

5 SECTION 20. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
6 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-758 of Title 63, unless there
7 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

8 A physician or other health care professional shall be immune
9 from criminal or civil liability for the death of a fetus resulting
10 from an emergency, including but not limited to an ectopic or tubal
11 pregnancy, if the physician or professional exhausts all possible
12 treatments to preserve the life of the fetus.

13 SECTION 21. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
14 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

15 The provisions, words, phrases and clauses of this act are
16 declared to be inseverable.

17 SECTION 22. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
