10	An Act relating to roads and bridges; amending 69 O.S. 2011, Section 601, which relates to county
11	highways; allowing boards of county commissioners to
12	enter into certain agreements to construct or maintain certain roads; and providing an effective date.

15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2011, Section 601, is
17	amended to read as follows:
18	Section 601. A. The county highway system shall be composed of
19	all public roads within any county, less any part of any road or
20	roads which may be designated as a state highway by the State
21	Transportation Commission. It shall be the duty of the board of
22	county commissioners in each county to construct and maintain as
23	county highways those roads which best serve the most people of the
24	county. For this purpose the board of county commissioners is

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authorized to use any funds which are in the county highway fund, subject to statutory restrictions on the use of any of such funds, together with any money or item of value derived from any agreement entered into between the county and the Transportation Commission, the federal government, this state, any other county or political subdivision of this state or other governmental entity, or any citizen or group of citizens who have made donations for that purpose. The boards of county commissioners of the various counties shall have exclusive jurisdiction over the designation, construction and maintenance and repair of all of the county highways and bridges therein. All interlocal cooperation agreements made pursuant to this section between counties and those political subdivisions or citizens of a county shall be submitted to the district attorney of each of the counties subject to the agreement for approval. other interlocal cooperation agreements shall be submitted and approved in accordance with Sections 1001 through 1008 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

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- B. The boards of county commissioners are hereby authorized to establish road improvement districts as provided by law for existing roads in the unincorporated areas of counties. The boards of county commissioners may also have improvements made on existing roads in unincorporated areas of counties on a force account basis.
- C. The boards of county commissioners of the various counties shall have authority and discretion to enter into an agreement with

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    a homeowners association within its respective county to construct
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    and/or maintain a public road, such as a road within a subdivision,
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    as long as at least three-fourths (3/4) of the citizens affected by
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    the road participate in the agreement and donate the funds necessary
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    for materials, labor and equipment to perform such work to the
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    county prior to the roadwork commencing. This statute shall not be
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    construed to give any county the authority to perform work on any
    citizen's private driveway or roadway that only serves that
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    homeowner or his or her family members. The county must enter into
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    an interlocal agreement with the citizens pursuant to subsection A
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    of this section.
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        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
