12 A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State  
13 to refer to the people for their approval or  
14 rejection a proposed amendment to Section 26 of  
15 Article II of the Oklahoma Constitution; expanding  
16 the rights of citizens to keep and bear arms;  
17 providing ballot title; and directing filing.

18 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE  
19 2ND SESSION OF THE 57TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

20 SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for  
21 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,  
22 the following proposed amendment to Section 26 of Article II of the  
23 Oklahoma Constitution to read as follows:

24 Section 26. A. The fundamental right of a each individual  
citizen to keep and to bear arms ~~in defense of his home, person, or~~



1 fundamental right of a citizen to keep and bear arms. This  
2 measure will not prevent the Legislature from adopting  
3 regulations that serve a compelling state interest. This  
4 measure would prohibit the imposition of registration or special  
5 taxation upon the keeping of arms or ammunition.
