13	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE		
14	1ST SESSION OF THE 57TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:		
15	SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for		
16	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,		
17	the following proposed amendment to Section 23 of Article V of the		
18	Oklahoma Constitution to read as follows:		
19	Section 23. No A. Except as otherwise provided in this section		
20	or in the Oklahoma Constitution, no member of the Legislature shall $_{ au}$		
21	during the term for which he was elected,:		
22	1. During the term for which he or she was elected, be		
23	appointed or elected to any office or commission in the State, which		
24			

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shall have been created, or the emoluments of which shall have been increased, during his or her term of office, nor shall any member;

- 2. During the term for which he or she was elected, receive any appointment from the Governor, the Governor and Senate, or from the Legislature, during the term for which he shall have been elected, nor shall any member, during;
- 3. During the term for which he shall have been or she was elected, or within two years thereafter, be interested, directly or indirectly, in any contract with the State, or any county or other subdivision thereof; or
- 4. Within two years after the expiration of the term for which he or she was elected, be interested directly or indirectly in any contract with the state, or any county, or other subdivision thereof, authorized by law passed during the term for which he shall have been or she was elected.
 - B. The provisions of this section shall not operate to:
- 1. Prohibit a member of the Legislature from providing services to a school district, technology center school district or The

 Oklahoma State System of Higher Education during his or her term of office, in a capacity for which he or she possesses qualifications unrelated to service as a member of the Legislature, during any period of time when the Legislature is not in regular session pursuant to the provisions of Section 26 of this article; or

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1	2. Prohibit a member of the Legislature from being appointed as		
2	a member of a legislative committee or to any other position held as		
3	a member of the Legislature.		
4	Provided further, neither the provisions of paragraph 3 of		
5	subsection A of this section, nor any other provision of law, shall		
6	operate to prohibit a former member of the Legislature from		
7	returning to the profession or business that he or she practiced		
8	prior to being elected.		
9	C. The Legislature is authorized to enact laws necessary to		
10	further implement the provisions of this section.		
11	SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional		
12	amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in		
13	the following form:		
14	BALLOT TITLE		
15	Legislative Referendum No State Question No		
16	THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:		
17	This measure amends Section 23 of Article 5 of the Oklahoma		
18	Constitution. This section prohibits members of the Legislature		
19	from engaging in certain activities during the term for which		
20	elected and, in some cases, for two years afterwards. This		
21	measure would change these prohibitions. Prohibited activity		
22	would include being appointed or elected to any office or		
23	commission in the state during the term, receiving any		

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appointment from the Governor, the Governor and Senate or the

Legislature during the term, being interested in any contract
with the state or a political subdivision during the term and
being interested in certain contracts within two years after the
term. These provisions would not prohibit a member of the
Legislature from providing services to a school district or the
Oklahoma State System of Higher Education when the Legislature
is not in regular session, or prohibit an appointment to a
legislative committee or other legislative position. They would
also not prohibit a former member from returning to his or her
profession or business. The Legislature could enact laws to
implement these provisions.
