Supp. 11 2018, Section 421), which relates to a veterans registry; providing registry name; modifying required 12 veteran information; modifying definition; directing the State Commissioner of Health to transmit certain 1.3 list and information to the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs; directing the Department to utilize 14 list and information to maintain certain registry; providing for codification; and providing an 15 effective date. 16 17 18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA: 19 SECTION 1. Section 1, Chapter 229, O.S.L. AMENDATORY 20 2017, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 387, O.S.L. 2017 (72 O.S. 21 Supp. 2018, Section 421), is amended to read as follows: 22 Section 421. A. The Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs 23 shall create and maintain a registry of all veterans in this state 24 by January 1, 2020. The registry shall be designated the "Oklahoma

1 <u>Veterans Registry" and shall</u> include the following information 2 regarding the veteran:

1. Name;

- 2. Military ranking rank and branch of service;
- 3. Dates of service;
- 4. Documentation Percentage of one hundred percent (100%)
 service-disability service-connected disability, if applicable; and
- 5. Date of death and place of burial interment, if applicable; and
 - 6. Name of spouse, if applicable.
- B. As a component of the veterans registry created pursuant to subsection A of this section, the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs shall designate those veterans within the registry as one—hundred_percent (100%) service-disabled Oklahoma veterans, if applicable. The registry designation shall also be maintained as a separate list within the registry for all one—hundred—percent (100%) service-disabled Oklahoma veterans. The Department shall be responsible for verification of all information provided through the registry and shall verify veteran service disability status at least once every four (4) years.
- C. The Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs shall promulgate rules for implementing the provisions of this section.
- D. For purposes of this section, "veteran" means a person who served on active duty in the Armed Forces of the United States who

was discharged or released with an honorable discharge. For those
veterans with a designation of one hundred percent (100%) servicedisabled, the veteran shall have been assigned a disability
percentage of one hundred percent (100%) by the United States
Department of Veterans Affairs shall have the same meaning as
specified in Section 2 of this title.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-317b of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The State Commissioner of Health shall authorize the regular transmission of a list to the Oklahoma Department of Veterans

Affairs of all registered deaths of residents of this state that have occurred within the state and who are indicated to be a veteran on the death record. The Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs shall use the transmitted list to identify Oklahoma veterans, as defined in Section 2 of Title 72 of the Oklahoma Statutes, for purposes of populating, updating and maintaining the veterans registry established in Section 421 of Title 72 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The Social Security number of an individual veteran shall not be released as a part of the registry. The State Health Department shall transmit to the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs the following information regarding:

- 1. The veteran's name;
- 2. The veteran's Social Security number;

3	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
