NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4050 of Title 69, unless there 22 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 23 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Victims of 2.4 Impaired Driving Memorial Sign Act of 2019".

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4051 of Title 69, unless there

is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

As used in the Victims of Impaired Driving Memorial Sign Act of 2019:

- 1. "Applicant" means any person requesting a sign on behalf of a victim as defined in this subsection;
- 2. "Impaired driver" means any driver who causes an accident involving a motor vehicle while intoxicated; and
- 3. "Victim" means any person killed in an accident involving an impaired driver. The term does not encompass a person that was considered an impaired driver.
- SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4052 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- A. There is hereby created a Victims of Impaired Driving

 Memorial Sign Program. The Program shall give family or friends of

 victims of impaired driving accidents the opportunity to purchase a

 sign to be placed near the site of an accident caused by impaired

 driving on any state highway, bridge or turnpike.
 - B. Memorial signs shall not be issued for impaired drivers.
- C. The sign panel shall measure forty-eight (48) inches by forty-two (42) inches.

- D. The memorial sign shall bear the words "Please Don't Drink and Drive. In Memory of" along with the legal name of the victim and the date of the accident. The sign shall have coral-colored background as defined by the latest version of the United States Department of Transportation's "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways". The applicant shall provide the investigating law enforcement agency's report or other government document showing that the accident occurred as the result of impaired driving.
- E. The cost associated with signage related to the Victims of Impaired Driving Memorial Sign Program shall be paid by the applicant requesting the sign. The sign shall be installed only after the application has been approved by the Oklahoma Department of Transportation and the cost has been collected. The Oklahoma Department of Transportation shall promulgate rules establishing a procedure to collect the cost of the sign. The cost of the sign shall be no greater than the cost to manufacture and install said sign.
- F. If the sign is damaged or stolen, the Oklahoma Department of Transportation shall replace the sign without charge to the applicant. Should damage or theft occur more than once, the Oklahoma Department of Transportation shall not replace the sign again without payment for a new sign by the original applicant.

1	G. An installed sign shall remain in place for a period of two
2	(2) years. At the end of that period, the sign shall be offered
3	back to the applicant. The applicant shall have thirty (30) days
4	from the time originally contacted in order to claim the expired
5	sign. After thirty (30) days, if the sign is not claimed by the
6	applicant, the sign shall be recycled.
7	H. Any other rules or administration of the Victims of Impaired
8	Driving Memorial Sign Program beyond the provisions outlined in the
9	Victims of Impaired Driving Memorial Sign Act of 2019 shall be
10	promulgated by rule at the discretion of the Oklahoma Department of
11	Transportation.
12	SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
