18 ~~United States or against an opposing military force; or~~

1       ~~C. The Department of Transportation shall promulgate rules~~  
2 ~~establishing a procedure to assess and collect the cost of the~~  
3 ~~signs. The assessment of cost shall include the cost of the initial~~  
4 ~~erection of the sign as well as the potential replacement or~~  
5 ~~reconstruction of the sign. The cost of these signs shall be based~~

8       SECTION 2.       AMENDATORY       Section 12, Chapter 372, O.S.L.  
9 2013, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 61, O.S.L. 2015 (69 O.S.  
10 Supp. 2018, Section 1600.1), is amended to read as follows:

11       Section 1600.1 Highways, bridges, and other facilities which  
12 are part of the state highway system may be considered for  
13 dedication in honor of individuals ~~deserving of commendation for~~  
14 ~~their active involvement in the project or for outstanding service~~  
15 ~~to the nation, this state, or their community. Persons proposed to~~  
16 ~~be so honored shall have been deceased not less than three (3) years~~  
17 ~~prior to consideration. The provisions of this section shall not~~  
18 ~~apply to the naming of highways and bridges on the state highway~~  
19 ~~system designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces,~~  
20 ~~members of law enforcement or firefighters fallen in the performance~~  
21 ~~of their duties. The provisions of this section shall also not~~  
22 ~~apply to the naming of highways and bridges on the state highway~~  
23 ~~system designed to honor Medal of Honor recipients both living and~~

1 ~~deceased. Proposals for the dedication of state highway facilities~~  
2 ~~should specifically state the accomplishments upon which the~~  
3 ~~proposal is based.~~
