14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 334 of Title 61, unless there is
17 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 All new construction of state and municipal buildings open to
19 the public commenced after January 1, 2022, and all renovations and
20 replacements of existing public state and municipal buildings open
21 to the public commenced after January 1, 2022, shall include at
22 least one baby changing table. This section shall only apply to
23 renovations and replacements if the renovation or replacement
24 exceeds fifty percent (50%) of the value of the state or municipal

1 building. If a baby changing table is not accessible in such a
2 building or facility to both men and women, the building code shall
3 require that the building or facility be equipped with at least one
4 such table accessible to men and at least one such table accessible
5 to women.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
