10	An Act relating to elections; amending 26 O.S. 2011,
11	Section 4-101, which relates to voter registration; clarifying conditions for voter eligibility; and
12	providing an effective date.

14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 4-101, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	Section 4-101. Every person who is a qualified elector as
18	defined by Section 1 of Article III of the Oklahoma Constitution
19	shall be entitled to become a registered voter in the precinct of
20	his or her residence, with the following exceptions conditions:
21	1. Persons convicted of a felony shall be ineligible eligible
22	to register for a period of time equal to the time prescribed in the
23	judgment and sentence. to vote when they have fully served their
24	sentence of court-mandated calendar days, including any term of

1	incarceration, parole or supervision, or completed a period of
2	probation ordered by any court; and
3	2. Any person who has been adjudged to be an incapacitated
4	person as such term is defined by Section 1-111 of Title 30 of the
5	Oklahoma Statutes $_{m{ au}}$ shall be ineligible to register to vote. When
6	such incapacitated person has been adjudged to be no longer
7	incapacitated such person shall be eligible to become a registered
8	voter. The provisions of this paragraph shall not prohibit any
9	person adjudged to be a partially incapacitated person as such term
10	is defined by Section 1-111 of Title 30 of the Oklahoma Statutes
11	from being eligible to register to vote unless the order adjudging
12	the person to be partially incapacitated restricts such persons
13	person from being eligible to register to vote.
14	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
