11                               COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

12           An Act relating to hunting; amending 29 O.S. 2011,  
13           Section 4-113, which relates to hunting and fishing  
14           annual combination licenses; creating annual  
15           landowner combination license; providing persons for  
16           which the license may be assigned; restricting  
17           validity of license to certain land; establishing  
18           fee; providing limit for the amount of licenses  
19           issued; authorizing the Department of Wildlife  
20           Conservation to require verification; requiring the  
21           Department to promulgate rules; and providing an  
22           effective date.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21           SECTION 1.           AMENDATORY           29 O.S. 2011, Section 4-113, is  
22           amended to read as follows:

23           Section 4-113. A. Legal residents who are not the individuals  
24           excepted from the license requirement as provided in subsection B of

1 Section 4-112 of this title may purchase an annual combination  
2 hunting/fishing license from the Director or agents of the Director.

3 B. The fee for each combination hunting/fishing license issued  
4 under this section shall be:

5 1. For legal residents eighteen (18) years of age and older for  
6 a license that expires on December 31 of the year purchased - Forty-  
7 one Dollars (\$41.00);

8 2. For residents eighteen (18) years of age and older for a  
9 license that expires on June 30 of the fiscal year purchased -  
10 Fifty-two Dollars (\$52.00);

11 3. For legal residents sixteen (16) or seventeen (17) years of  
12 age for a license that expires on December 31 of the year purchased  
13 - Thirteen Dollars (\$13.00); and

14 4. For legal residents sixteen (16) or seventeen (17) years of  
15 age for a license that expires on June 30 of the fiscal year  
16 purchased - Eighteen Dollars (\$18.00).

17 C. Legal residents and nonresidents may purchase an annual  
18 combination hunting and fishing landowner license. The license  
19 provided for in this subsection may be assigned to the landowner's  
20 siblings and lineal ascendants or descendants and their spouses,  
21 whether or not they are Oklahoma residents. The license shall only  
22 be valid for the land that it is issued to. The license fee shall  
23 be the same as any of the Oklahoma resident annual hunting license  
24 fees in subsection B of this section. The total number of annual

1 combination hunting and fishing landowner licenses issued shall not  
2 exceed one license for each eighty (80) acres owned by the  
3 landowner. Evidence of ownership, sibling, lineal ascending or  
4 descending relations or spousal relationship, if requested, shall be  
5 provided to the Department of Wildlife Conservation. The Department  
6 shall promulgate rules to enforce the provisions of this subsection.

7 D. Of the fees collected pursuant to the provisions of  
8 paragraphs 1 and 2 of subsection B of this section, Five Dollars  
9 (\$5.00) of the license fee shall be for the Oklahoma Wildlife Land  
10 Stamp and shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Wildlife Land Fund  
11 created pursuant to the provisions of Section 4-141 of this title.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
