L 9	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be

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	A. It is the intent of the Legislature for the Board of

 - B. It is the intent of the Legislature for:
 - 1. The Board of Medicolegal Investigations to utilize Five
 Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$5,500,000.00) from the funds
 appropriated to the Board of Medicolegal Investigations in Enrolled
 House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma
 Legislature, toward the furtherance of the provisions of subsection
 A of this section;
 - 2. The Board of Medicolegal Investigations to utilize Four Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$4,500,000.00) from existing agency resources toward the furtherance of the provisions of subsection A of this section; and
 - 3. The Oklahoma State University Center for Health Sciences (OSU-CHS) to utilize Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000.00) from the funds received by OSU-CHS pursuant to Dean's GME program transition payments, toward the furtherance of the provisions of subsection A of this section.
