12 An Act relating to the Board of Medicolegal
13 Investigations; providing legislative intent related
14 to certain construction; providing legislative intent
15 related to utilization of certain resources by the
16 Board of Medicolegal Investigations and the Oklahoma
17 State University Center for Health Sciences; and
18 providing for noncodification.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
20 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

21 A. It is the intent of the Legislature for the Board of
22 Medicolegal Investigations to partner with the Oklahoma State
23 University Center for Health Sciences (OSU-CHS) for the purpose of
24 constructing a building that includes adequate space for the Tulsa

1 location for the Board of Medicolegal Investigations, as well as
2 space for OSU-CHS as agreed to between OSU-CHS and the Board of
3 Medicolegal Investigations.

4 B. It is the intent of the Legislature for:

5 1. The Board of Medicolegal Investigations to utilize Five
6 Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$5,500,000.00) from the funds
7 appropriated to the Board of Medicolegal Investigations in Enrolled
8 House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma
9 Legislature, toward the furtherance of the provisions of subsection
10 A of this section;

11 2. The Board of Medicolegal Investigations to utilize Four
12 Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$4,500,000.00) from existing
13 agency resources toward the furtherance of the provisions of
14 subsection A of this section; and

15 3. The Oklahoma State University Center for Health Sciences
16 (OSU-CHS) to utilize Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000.00) from
17 the funds received by OSU-CHS pursuant to Dean's GME program
18 transition payments, toward the furtherance of the provisions of
19 subsection A of this section.
